## **MAINTENANCE GUIDE**

STAINLESS STEEL STAIR NOSING PROFILES WITH PVC INFILL **Product Range: Materials** Stair Nosing Profile: Grade 304L Stainless Steel Infill: PVC Compound Immediately after installation and the removal of protective tape, the stair nosing **General:** profile should be wiped with a dry, soft cloth to remove any handling marks and fingerprints. These stainless steel stair nosings are produce with a bright or brushed finish. The installed profile should be swept clean on a daily basis to avoid build up of dust and dirt which may make it more difficult to maintain its appearance and adversely affect performance. Stainless steel profiles generally need little maintenance but heavy soiling can be **Stair Nosing Profile:** cleaned using soap, ammonial or detergent and warm water. Sponge the soiled area with the solution, then rinse with clean water and dry. Goddards Stainless Steel Care may be used for stubborn stains. Always follow the manufacturer's instructions for use. Wipe clean with a mild detergent, diluted with water, on a damp, not wet, cloth **PVC Infill:** Ensure that all surfaces are wiped dry after cleaning before opening the staircase Important: to pedestrian traffic. Care must be taken to protect surrounding floor finishes during maintenance.

A small piece of velvet pile carpet, used upside down, will help clean to the

bottom of castellated infill features.
