Product Range: STAINLESS STEEL FLOORING PROFILES

manufacturer's instructions for use.

Material Grade: 304L Stainless Steel

General:

The installed profile should be swept clean on a daily basis to avoid build up of dust and dirt which may make it more difficult to maintain its appearance.

Immediately after installation and the removal of protective tape, the flooring profile should be wiped with a dry, soft cloth to remove any handling marks and fingerprints.

Stainless steel flooring profiles are produce with a bright or brushed finish.

Cleaning:

Stainless steel profiles generally need little maintenance but heavy soiling can be cleaned using soap, ammonial or detergent and warm water.

Sponge the soiled area with the solution, then rinse with clean water and dry. Goddards Stainless Steel Care may be used for stubborn stains. Always follow the

Prolonged exposure to damp environments, acids or strong alkali solutions may lead to corrosion of the metal.

Fixing Advice:

Stainless steel profiles, when mechanically fixed, should be secured using stainless steel screws to prevent possible bi-metallic corrosion.

Important:

Ensure that all surfaces are wiped dry after cleaning before allowing pedestrian access.

Care must be taken to protect surrounding floor finishes during maintenance.
